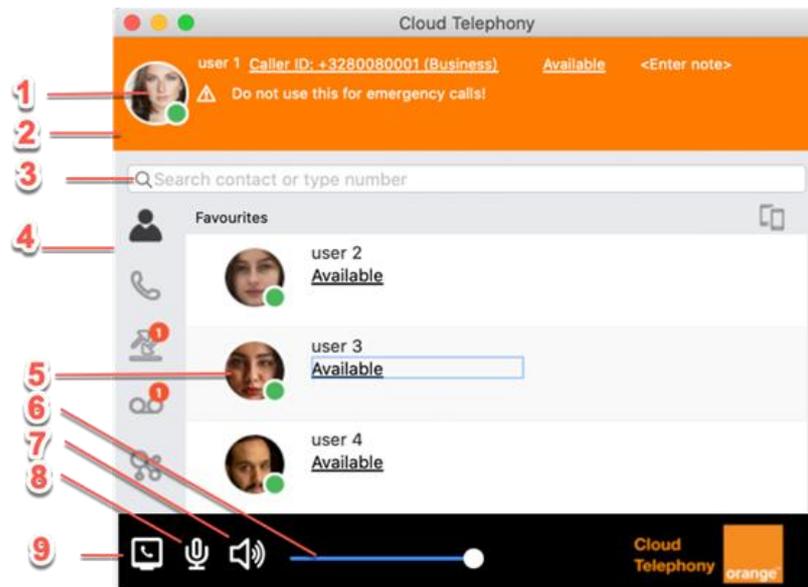


## Cloud telephony – PC Application



1.	User photo area. Contains your picture and presence Clicking on your picture opens your vCard.
2.	Live aid area. You can see your name, Caller ID, your note Important notifications, for example, transfers
3.	Search field.
4.	Tab bar. Contains tabs to switch between the different views.
5.	Contacts/Calls/Log view. Each tab view contains different information regarding contacts, ongoing calls, log, etc.
6.	Volume bar.
7.	Click to toggle between speaker/headset mode.
8.	Click to mute/unmute microphone. Access to microphone needs to be granted on macOS Mojave. See Installation and activation for more information.
9.	Click to switch which device to call from (Call using).
